The City of Newport Wayfinding Committee met on the above date in Conference Room B of the Newport City Hall. - 1. Call to Order
 - The meeting was called to order by Chair Geltner at 8:30 PM.
- 2. Approval of Minutes
 - a. November 3, 2016 minutes were approved
- 3. Discussion/action items
 - a. 2017 Goals
 - i. City Recorder Peggy Hawker briefed the committee on the process.
 - ii. After discussion, the committee developed three goals to forward to the City Manager.
 - 1. Revise, reprint, and install Wayfinding Maps prior to each Memorial Day. Estimated cost \$5,000.00
 - Collaborate with Bike and Pedestrian Committee and Arts Committee to develop pedestrian maps relative to their respective areas of interest, with the end goal of adding a QR code or other references to the Wayfinding Map.
 - 3. Develop funding for "quick-fix" solutions to Wayfinding signage and continue to improve Wayfinding in the coming year through budget items. Estimated cost: \$2,000.

 - a. A motion was made to adopt the City's "bridge" icon as the Wayfinding Map icon, to replace the crab that is currently in place. The motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.
